The night will feature dinosaur stories & crafts. Be ready to ROAR!

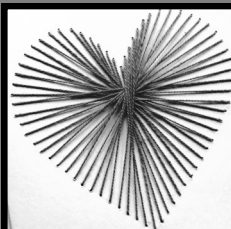
Feb. 25th: Pajama Story Time
