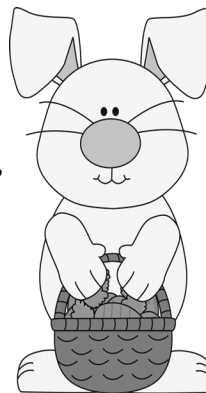
Annual Meeting
